Your rights

You have the right to information about the personal data concerning you (Art. 15 GDPR), a right to rectification (Art. 16 GDPR), erasure (Art. 17 GDPR) and restriction of processing (Art. 18 GDPR), a right to object to processing (Art. 21 GDPR) as well as the right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR), as far as these rights exist according to the mentioned provisions in the respective individual case. You can assert these rights with us at any time, and you have the right to complain to the responsible supervisory authority (in particular your EU domicile, or with the Austrian data protection authority).

Data deletion and storage period

Your personal data will be deleted or blocked as soon as the purpose of storage no longer applies. In addition, your personal data may be stored if this has been provided for by European or national legislation, in Union regulations, laws or other regulations to which we are subject. The data will also be blocked or deleted if a storage period prescribed by the aforementioned standards expires, unless further storage of the data is necessary for the conclusion or fulfilment of a contract.

Legal basis

As a matter of principle, we process your personal data only to the extent necessary to provide the services and content you have requested as well as a functioning website.

Insofar as we obtain your consent for the processing of personal data, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) serves as the legal basis. If personal data is processed on the basis of your consent, you have the right to revoke this consent at any time with effect for the future.

If the processing of your personal data is necessary to fulfil a contract to which you are a party, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b GDPR serves as the legal basis. This also applies to processing operations that are necessary for pre-contractual measures.

Insofar as the processing of personal data is necessary to fulfil a legal obligation to which the Austrian Red Cross is subject, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. c GDPR serves as the legal basis.

In the event that vital interests of you or another natural person require the processing of personal data, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. d GDPR serves as the legal basis.

If the processing is necessary to safeguard a legitimate interest of ours or a third party and if the interests, fundamental rights and fundamental freedoms of the data subject do not outweigh the first-mentioned interest, Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f GDPR serves as the legal basis for the processing. If we process data on the basis of a weighing of interests, you as the data subject have the right to object to the processing of personal data, taking into account the provisions of Art. 21 GDPR.

Purposes

Your data will be processed for the registration, organisation and implementation of the course (online phase as well as face-to-face meeting) (contractual or pre-contractual measures).

Transmission of personal data

The course can only be held because it is part of a project co-funded by third parties and, if applicable, held together with co-organisers. We are obliged to submit a list of the participating persons to our funding bodies (Federal Ministry of the Interior, Austrian Integration Fund, EU AMIF fund) and to any co-organisers as proof of the activity. This list includes: First name, last name, organisation, country and event.

The course uses the platform of the European Union Agency for Asylum (EUAA) training curriculum. Therefore, your data will also be transferred to and processed by the EUAA for the purpose of course participation.

Source of the data
